For the first time on Blu-ray, this beloved adaptation of the Broadway stage hit stars Hepburn as a sassy, working class London street vendor whom an arrogant professor (Rex Harrison) attempts to turn into a sophisticated lady through proper schooling. But, when the humble flower girl blossoms into the toast of London's elite, her teacher may have a lesson or two to learn himself. Best of Enemies This documentary, directed by Robert Gordon and Morgan Neville, details the historic 1968 televised debates between staunch conservative William F. Buckley Jr. and the liberal writer, Gore Vidal. Firmly planted in their respective ideologies, the men often fought bitterly in their attempts to discredit each other, nearly coming to blows on more than one occasion. The film delves into their personal histories, mining for clues as to how the contrary political leanings of these two brilliant but complicated men evolved. Magnolia

Before We Go After a young married woman (Alice Eve) is robbed and misses her train out of New York, a street musician (Chris Evans) offers to help her and they spend the night exploring the city together.
