The Streets of San Francisco Season 2 Volume 1 While it never achieved the success of such better-known shows as *Kojak* or *Starsky & Hutch*, the Quinn Martin-produced *The Streets of San Francisco* remains one of the highlights of the 1970s television crime-drama boom. The action-packed series also made a star of the then up-and-coming actor Michael Douglas, who, along with Karl Malden, anchored the cast as a father-and-son-like duo of crime-fighting San Francisco police detectives: 20-year veteran Mike Stone (Malden) and his eager rookie partner, Steve Keller (Douglas). Filmed on location in the city by the bay, the series distinguished itself with great acting, intricate storylines, inventive opening credits, and an indelible theme song. Jake and the Fatman William Conrad stars as Jason Lochinvar "Fatman" McCabe, a rotund, cigar-chomping district attorney with a bulldog's tenacity. Stargate Atlantis Season 4 The Stargate universe is exhilaratingly expanded and the epic feel of the franchise is perfected in this acclaimed spin-off of the Stargate SG-1 series, itself spun-off from the 1994 blockbuster from director Roland Emmerich. In Stargate: Atlantis, an international crew of scientists and soldiers finds yet another Stargate...one which leads to the Lost City of Atlantis. This Stargate, though, isn't on Earth but in the far-away Pegasus Galaxy, and the secret city holds a formidable new enemy--the Wraith. With this fourth season of the hit sci-fi series, things take a turn in a bleak new direction, with team leader Dr. Weir injured and captured by the evil Asurans as the damaged city of Atlantis drifts through space. Meanwhile, McKay reprograms the Asuran base code, causing the alien race to wage a war with the Wraith. Finally, hybrid Michael plays against both the humans and his own former Wraith race as this electric season hurtles toward its thrilling conclusion. Sci-Fi Ultimate Collection Volume 1 & 2 Hideous monsters, high-pitched screams, and invaders from outer space all figure in this collection of classic sci-fi. Though their special effects may be a bit dated, what makes these films great are their imaginative storylines and vintage feel. Included here are Tarantula, The Mole People, The Incredible Shrinking Man, The Monolith Monsters, Monster On The Campus, Dr. Cyclops, Cult Of The Cobra, The Land Unknown, And The Deadly Mantis And The Leech Woman. Tarantula Kindly Dr. Reemer (Leo G. Carroll) has big plans for his new radioactive serum. It makes animals grow at a fantastic rate, and this could solve the world's food shortage, but when an accident at his Arizona laboratory leads to a tarantula injected with the serum escaping, havoc results. The eerily silent desert is soon a lot scarier, as cattle and humans start disappearing at an alarming rate. Local doctor Matt Hastings (John Agar) and Reemer's shapely assistant (Mara Corday) finally figure out what's going on after the enormous spider attacks the house where she is staying. Tarantula is considered one of the best giant bug movies of the 1950s. Director Jack Arnold is a master at conveying unearthly menace through the desert landscape, and the scenes of the gigantic tarantula creeping over the horizons are chillingly effective. The memorable score is by Henry Mancini and Herman Stein. Clint Eastwood pops up in the end as a jet squad leader, though he's hidden by his oxygen mask. The Mole People in The Mole People, a team of archeologists on a quest to find a lost race instead discover a horrific tribe of people living underground who have brutally enslaved the creepy half-human mole people., The Incredible Shrinking Man When an ordinary businessman encounters a mysterious radioactive mist during a boating trip, his life takes a bizarre and frightening twist. Soon he finds he is shrinking and within weeks he's just two inches tall battling cats and spiders., The Monolith Monsters A university professor joins forces with a geologist to save the world from the deadly pieces of a giant meteorite, left behind after it crash landed in California, threatening the surrounding community.

Monster on the Campus Arthur Franz stars in this far-out science fiction film as Donald, a professor of paleontology who receives a prehistoric fish at all-American Dunston University. First a student's dog licks up some of the fish's spilled blood and sprouts fangs and tries to kill his owner. Then the professor cuts his hand on the fish's mouth, goes wild and kills his friend Molly Reardon (Helen Westcott). He doesn't remember what happened, and it doesn't much bother him, but his girlfriend (Joanna Moore) is awfully worried. Later, a dragonfly lands on the fish and then assumes prehistoric size, but the brilliant professor still can't figure out what's going on. He accidentally smokes some of the dragonfly's blood in a pipe and he's off on another killing spree. Whit Bissell is the head of Dunston's science department, and scoffs at the whole nonsensical business. Troy Donahue and Nancy Walters are the good-hearted teenagers who try and help. It's a minor entry in the 1950s science fiction genre, but Monster On The Campus is fun in an off-kilter sort of way., Vol. 2 Dr. Cyclops A sci-fi/horror classic about a mad scientist who invents a radium machine that enables him to shrink animals and humans. A group of engineers and biologists are captured and reduced to miniatures when they stumble upon Dr. Cyclops' secret laboratory in South America. Afterwards, danger looms large for the tiny travelers as they escape through the jungle, the evil doctor in hot pursuit. , Cult of the Cobra While stationed in Asia, six American G.I.'s witness the secret ritual of Lamians (worshippers of women who can change into serpents). When discovered by the cult, the High Lamian Priest vows that "the Cobra Goddess will avenge herself". Once back in the United States, a mysterious woman enters into their lives and accidents begin to happen. The shadow of a cobra is seen just before each death., The Land Of The Unknown On a naval expedition to Antarctica, three men and reporter Maggie Hathaway crash-land in a crater 1000 m below sea level. There, they encounter steamy tropical forest, dinosaurs, carnivorous plants, and human footprints , The Deadly Mantis A gigantic praying mantis lying frozen in the Arctic Circle, near the Weddell Sea is freed by an erupting volcano. It then makes its way to New York, causing death and destruction as only a giant praying mantis could. Can the armed forces answer everyone's "prayers" by conducting a successful raid on the brazen bug? & The Leech Woman On a trip to Africa with her scientist husband (Phillip Terry), June (Colleen Gray) learns he plans to use her as a guinea pig in his anti-aging experiment. But June turns the tables by killing him instead and using his pineal gland in a tribal ritual that keeps her youthful. Now, she must keep finding fresh male victims in order to continue performing the ancient ceremony to maintain her newfound youth in this classic horror flick.

The show revolves around the exploits of Pentagon agents Kelly Robinson (Robert Culp) and Alexander Scott (Bill Cosby), who work undercover by disguising themselves as a tennis pro and his trainer. The two agents travel the world, including locations in Hong Kong and Tokyo in this season, in search of potentially deadly criminals. The show proved so popular that a series of spin-off novels, a comic book, and a feature film all followed, and I Spy retains a strong cult following among fans drawn to its subtle blend of action and humor. The first-born siblings dubbed Boy, Son and Kid -- impersonal monikers that embody their father's indifference toward them explode in anger upon meeting their counterparts, who have real names and reaped the rewards of their father's later success. *Liberation*

Steel Trap If attending a blow-out bash on the top floor of a tall skyscraper, don't respond to any text messages inviting you to a "V.I.P." party on the 27th floor because, nine times out of ten, they're from a guy who has transformed the very building into a self-contained murder machine by setting up an elaborate network of traps. It's Saw meets Die Hard as seven not-so-lucky invitees ignore the advice. *Weinstein/Genius*

Toxic After escaping from a mental asylum, a young woman embarks on a killing spree when her gangster father puts a price on her head in this direct-to-video thriller from director Alan Pao. As she cuts a swath of death and destruction, a nightclub owner, a barkeeper, a hooker, a clairvoyant and an exotic dancer are in her crosshairs. The cast includes rapper Master P, Dominique Swain, Danny Trejo and Tom Sizemore. *Genius*

Triloquist With their homicidal ventriloquist dummy in tow, twisted orphans Angelina (Paydin LoPachin) and her silent brother, Norbert (Rocky Marquette), leave a trail of bodies in their wake as they hit the road to Las Vegas to make it big. Along the way, Angelina -- hell-bent on continuing the family bloodline -- abducts a girl (Katie Chonacas) for Norbert to inseminate, but the scheme goes awry in this darkly comic tale of horror helmed by Mark Jones. *Genius*

Shutter This American remake of a Thai horror blockbuster follows the Shaws, a young newlywed couple who become haunted by strange shadowlike images in the photographs they develop after their involvement in a car accident. As more terrifying supernatural occurrences befall them, they begin to wonder whether the photographic ghosts are connected to the accident -- and to question whether they can survive learning the truth. *Fox*

Asylum Six college girls learn their dorm used to house a horrific insane asylum in the 1930s where a sadistic doctor performed numerous grisly lobotomies on his disturbed teenage patients in this sinister spine chiller. It seems that the ghost of the doctor still haunts the corridors, and he's determined to continue his ghastly experiments on the current students. Now the friends must join forces to escape the psycho spirit -- or go insane trying. *Fox*

His romantic interest in the gorgeous, tough-as-nails Layla (Bridget Moynahan), a fellow trainee, becomes a weakness as the pressure of the tests steadily increases. Finally, without warning, Clayton is thrown into action as he and Burke go head-to-head in a mission that is more dangerous than either of them realize.
