Fist of Fear Touch of Death 40th Anniversary Based on the childhood of the famous kung-fu fighter Bruce Lee, this film follows the incidents that occurred at a martial arts competition in Madison Square Garden. Film clips of the late Bruce Lee are featured in this movie. A subgenre of 1970s cinema, Bruceploitation clung to the box office success of the Bruce Lee legacy after the star's untimely demise in 1973, utilizing Lee lookalikes and archival footage from the legend himself. Carving a niche within the grindhouse market, Bruceploitation not only appealed to fans of the day, but has generated a cult status in recent years. True to Bruceploitation fashion, Fist of Fear, Touch of Death features eye-popping combat scenes viewers will have to see to believe, putting the 1979 World Karate Championship at center stage, where martial artists take their shot at eliminating the competition and claiming the title of "successor to the Bruce Lee legacy."
