While Javier hates Sergio for what he does to Natalia, he has a hard time working up the courage to stand up to the bully, much as his father was hard pressed to stop Franco's violent minions. *Magnolia*

Conan O'Brien Can't Stop Director Rodman Flender offers a candid look at one of the most difficult chapters in Conan O'Brien's turbulent career while following the popular late-night talk-show host on his 32-city "Legally Prohibited From Being Funny on Television Tour." West Side Story Considered one of the most popular musicals of all time, *West Side Story* earned director Robert Wise an Oscar for Best Director as well as nine other Academy Awards, including Best Picture. Realistically portrayed characters and their surroundings and expert editing complementing innovative dance sequences mark this highly stylized modern-day Romeo and Juliet tale. When Tony, on Maria's urging, tries to stop a rumble between the gangs, tragedy ensues, marking their dedicated love affair with violence and desperation. The infectious, lyrical landmark score by Leonard Bernstein and Stephen Sondheim help round out one of the greatest musical experiences ever captured on film. *MGM*

My Fair Lady A priceless classic, *My Fair Lady* has become one of the most popular musicals of all time. Based on George Bernard Shaw's 1913 play *Pygmalion*, the film swept the Academy Awards. Cecil Beaton's lavish sets and costumes and Lerner and Loewe's winning score became the background for George Cukor's striking mix of styles that ranged from the fantastic to the abstract in his telling of the tale of a waif who's educated into being a lady. Egotistical linguist Professor Henry Higgins (Oscar-winning Rex Harrison) bets his friend, Colonel Hugh Pickering (Wilfrid Hyde-White), that he can transform Cockney flower girl Eliza Doolittle (Audrey Hepburn) in time for an important society ball. His gamble could pay off--but the spirited Eliza is more of a handful than the Professor could have predicted. As she slowly becomes more refined, and less reliant upon him, Higgins realizes, to his confusion, that he can't live without her. *Paramount*

Tucker & Dale vs. Evil Tucker and Dale are two best friends on vacation at their dilapidated mountain house, who are mistaken for murderous backwoods hillbillies by a group of obnoxious, preppy college kids. When one of the students gets separated from her friends, the boys try to lend a hand, but as the misunderstanding grows, so does the body count. *Magnolia*

Helldriver When a toxic cloud turns the entire population of Northern Japan into hideous flesh eaters, a courageous schoolgirl ventures into forbidden territory on a mission to take down the dreaded Zombie Queen in this gruesome horror adventure from director Yoshihiro Nishimura (Tokyo Gore Police). In order to prevent the zombie plague from spreading into the southern region, the government has built a massive wall across the middle of the country. Meanwhile, the debate rages over whether the undead should be destroyed on sight, or safeguarded until a cure can be found. But if the Zombie Queen can be destroyed, the curse of the living dead will finally be broken.

With an artificial heart that keeps on pumping and a chainsaw sword that never gets dull, heroic high school warrior Kika (Yumiko Hara) receives government orders to defeat the Zombie Queen and restore order to the island country. It won't be easy, but thanks to a small squadron of fearless outlaws by her side, Kika might just have what it takes to save humanity from a terrible fate. *Well Go*

Mangus A super fun, dark trailer-trash comedy from Ash Christian (*Fat Girls*), *Mangus!* revolves around high school senior Mangus Spedgewick (Ryan Boggus) who hopes to fulfill his family's tradition of playing Jesus in the local annual production of "Jesus Christ Spectacular." This fresh cult hit co-stars Jennifer Coolidge, John Waters, Leslie Jordan, Heather Matarazzo and Deborah Theaker. Mangus Spedgewick is handicapped. Make that "handicapable." He lost his legs in a tragic drunk driving accident the night of his high school prom. Now with a father who is going to fight the war in Iraq, and a stepmother who simply can't handle the "upkeep" of the young crippled, Mangus goes to live with his birth mother, Cookie and stepfather (who is only a few years older than him) and his lesbian half sister in a secluded trailer park in the small town of Rivercity, Texas. While there, he auditions for the role of Jesus in their community theater production of *Jesus Christ Spectacular* (the cheap offspring of *Jesus Christ Superstar*)...but the town leaders don't want a crippled Jesus. Mangus decides to take on their discriminatory casting and fights their decision. Will he get to be their town's first crippled Jesus? Not without a hard fight, a road trip and breaking the law a few times along the way. *Wolfe*
